Attendance Patterns

We are open from 08:15am until 6:15pm and various attendance patterns are offered subject to availability:

Nursery 3 months - 3 years

Nursery

All children will attend all-year round until the term after their 3rd birthday. They will then automatically transfer to term time attendance sessions and fees from the start of the following term will reflect this.

Pre-Prep

Children aged 3 to 4 years follow a school term attendance pattern. For children attending 5 days per week, fees are the same for each term, irrespective of the actual length of the term.

Holiday Club

Holiday Club is provided outside of our standard term dates for our children as well as external children aged 3 to 5 years old and must be booked in advance.

Our Classes

Lower Nursery

We know just how important these first years are, and how much the children begin to learn and develop. We pride ourselves on giving even our youngest children a broad range of experiences to challenge them and to begin to foster a love of discovery and exploration within a calm nurturing environment. District Class is our under 2's home from home and is situated on the lower ground floor. This classroom is the perfect environment for children to challenge themselves and develop a strong exploratory impulse as well as building their social skills.

Upper Nursery

Upper Nursery is designed to support our 2-year-olds in their continued development. We understand that children of this age still need a great deal of emotional support as they build their bodies and minds in preparation for later learning. We provide each child with a tailored approach to ensure they get the most out of this room. Children are given a mixture of structured learning, free play and garden time, while also developing valuable social and self-care skills.

Lower Pre-Prep

Lower Pre-Prep focuses on building on the skills taught in Piccadilly Class, including practical life skills. Additional structured learning is in place to start to teach children phonics and numeracy alongside a wide range of topics to broaden their understanding of the world around them. Physical, social and language development are still key at this age, and so we provide regular opportunities for Central Class to join with their older peers to learn from them and challenge themselves. We provide regular garden time and provide climbing equipment, tricycles, scooters, balance bikes and other sports equipment to promote physical activity alone and as a group.

Upper Pre-Prep

Upper Pre-Prep is aimed at providing school readiness for children who will be going to Reception Class the following September, while still allowing them to have fun and build their personalities before school really starts! We have a focus on Mathematics and Literacy in this class, but also put an emphasis on creativity and external experiences, with trips to parks, museums and art installations.

The Important Bits

Parent Partnership

Our aim is to provide children with the highest quality of care and education and to meet the individual needs and circumstances of every child and their family. In order to achieve this, we aim to work in partnership with parents and carers to make the setting a welcoming place where children settle quickly and easily. At HPPN we champion parental involvement and encourage parents to be involved in all aspects of nursery life!

Refuelling

Holland Park Pre-Prep and Nursery promotes Healthy Eating through the provision of fresh, nutritious, and varied food in a balanced format across the different food groups. Snack and mealtimes are an important part of the child's day. While at Nursery the children will be able to enjoy two hot meals which are prepared onsite by our amazing head chef Miss Vivian. Mealtimes provide children with the opportunity to develop skills of independence through self-feeding, making choices and using age-appropriate utensils.

Sustainability

At HPPN we wish to support children to learn about sustainable practices and foster respect and care for the living and non-living environment. Children are able to develop positive attitudes and values about sustainable practices by exploring solutions to environmental issues, learning about the world around them and how to protect it, and watching adults role model sustainable practices. We promote a holistic, open-ended curriculum which explores ideas and practices for environmental sustainability and helps children understand the interdependence between people and the environment.

The Great Outdoors

At HPPN we are committed to the importance of daily outdoor play and the physical development of all children regardless of their age and stage of development. We provide outdoor play in all weathers. We are lucky enough to have a large outdoor space for children to explore and create long lasting memories with their peers.
